Jul 1	Tue	8:30am - Set-up is complete/vigil becomes continuous. Vigilers who wish will stay out all night.
Jul 2	Wed	27th Anniversary of Gregg v. Georgia *11:15pm - Final gathering at SCOTUS
Jul 3	Thu	*12:01am - Break the Fast, featuring a meal lovingly prepared by the Dorothy Day Catholic Worker House *11am: Everyone must be out of CCNV
