### **WHAT TO BRING**

We **STRONGLY** suggest you bring the following items with you to the Fast and Vigil:

\* Light clothes. The weather will be sunny, hot and humid. Thunderstorms are common at this time of year - we always have at least one very strong downpour. At night, the weather will be dark, with wildly spreading light in the morning. On occasion, the all-night vigil has been damp and chilly.

\* Sunscreen AND sunglasses AND hat.

\* Rain gear

\* Water bottle

\* Folding chairs and an ice chest (if you are driving to the F&V)

\* Low denomination bills for Metro fare cards (if you plan to use public transportation)

\* Money for AbolitionWear, and YES, there will be an official Fast & Vigil t-shirt!

### **OPTIONAL**

\* Camera

### **If you are staying with us at CCNV....**

If you plan to stay at CCNV, you may arrive there any time after 1pm on June 28. Check-out time is no later than 11am on July 3.

### **BRING....**

\* a sleeping bag OR bed linen

\* a pillow

\* a towel

\* shower shoes

\* a flashlight

\* EARPLUGS and an EYESHADE if you are a light sleeper.

NOTE: Blankets will be available. (CCNV's air conditioning was operational last year)
